Publication of short-text papers

Authors may submit short papers (2–3 pages) for publication in the conference proceedings. A template for short papers and author guidelines are available on the conference [website](#).

All participants will be awarded a **certificate of participation**.

Publication of full-text papers

Authors whose short papers are included in the conference program will be invited to submit complete and original full-text papers in English. International authors may submit a full-text paper without prior submission of a short paper

Full-text papers will be published in the **Springer Lecture Notes on Data Engineering and Communications Technologies (LNDECT)** series (<https://www.springer.com/series/15362>). The LNDECT series has an assigned ISSN and is indexed in the Scopus database.

Paper submission will be enabled via a dedicated link, which **will be announced** on the conference [website](#) **shortly**.

Important!

Each author submitting a full-text paper agrees to serve as a **peer reviewer** for one to two other submissions. In addition, at least one co-author of each accepted full-text paper **must register for the conference and present the topic**. Papers whose authors fail to register and present at the conference will not be included in the final publication.
